INTRODUCTION

The PS 279 school pledge includes the phrase, "I will use what I have learned to be a good citizen and help make my school a better place." As guest artists visiting a school for the first time, it is incredibly important to be engaged with the school values and community. This was especially fitting for our residency at 279, which aligned with the 2nd grade social studies curriculum centered on community and citizenship.

After exploring character, setting, conflict, and dialogue, we helped students draft original plays and watched their confidence grow onstage. We then revised our plays, asking, "What do we want the audience to feel?" In the final class students acted out their stories wearing costumes and inhabiting all different types of animals and people in New York.

Some of our favorite games together included Bus Stop, Fortunately/ Unfortunately, and tongue twisters like "Unique New York--You know you need unique New York!" In this anthology we've also included photos of some "serious acting" and silly moments, along with students' drawings of their original plays.

Our time together playing drama games, expanding our vocabulary, and diving into complex themes of our environment is reflected not only in the students' original words, but also in the murals on display at PS 279 for every student, staff member, and visitor to see. Through this residency, students have made their school and community a better place, a place that reflects their unique points of view and celebrates an artistic vision of the future.

Special thanks to our incredible students, every paraprofessional, and all the teachers at this school that are a second family to so many young lives. We are rooting for you, always.



Superpower Girl: I'll fly you home, Bear.



(Animals are playing catch with a ball and trying


